- Tax-exempt Status Reinstated
  - Retroactive!
    - Donations made while the foundation did not have 501c3 status are still taxdeductible.
  - o Form 990 can be filed now Sam to do
- Fundraising Brainstorm!!!!!
  - Carol will draft a letter to all previous donors asking for help bringing the next BRAKES training to Juneau.
    - In addition, we should think of other potential donors to add to the list of recipients
    - Mention that all donations goes to the training, there are no administrative costs.
  - We should look into using Square to accept donations via Credit Cards at events like BRAKES.
